The election of Board members of the AKC was held. Since there were no petitions for nominations, the Nominating Committee selections were elected. They are: Chris Sweetwood, Harold Tatro and Ann Wallin. New Delegates were read and one new club was elected into membership to AKC.

Tom Davies gave the Chairman's report and it was dedicated to the memory of Ron Menaker and his many achievements for the AKC and for his friendship with Ron. I too was fortunate to have had a friendship with Ron and admired his love of the dogs, the sport and what all he did for AKC.

A very lengthy report was read by Brandi Hunter Munden. Comments were made regarding the AKC involvement with media coverage for the AKC. They have reached out to the public by ESPN, Good Morning America and the Associated Press to name a few organizations. A positive financial report was read.


