2. NKC Scent Work Trial Wrap Up – The trial went well. Shelly will get volunteer vouchers sent. **Motion #2** (Norine/Barb) – Donate \$1000 to the Cass County K9 Unit. Motion passed. Sheryl will contact Cody Laursen from the Cass County Sheriff's Department and invite them to the August meeting. If they are unable to attend, Sheryl will take the check to their office and present it to them.
3. Detective Trial Wrap Up – Finances were discussed with the Treasurers report and the event went well.

FAST CAT

Nebraska Kennel Club Fast CAT September 17-18th, 2022

Fastest Dogs in the US.

Two Events Each Day — Concurrent Format

Limited practice slots available Friday after 5pm, contact trial secretary.

Entry Closing Date: Entries must be received no later than Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at 6 pm CDT

Fast CAT is a 100 yard dash which dogs compete against the clock. Break the beam timing.

SPECIFIC FAST CAT® RULES & INFORMATION

1. Fast CAT® is a pass/fail event.
2. Dogs run singly on a fenced-in course.
3. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted to miles per hour (MPH). Formula: $204.545/\text{Dog's Time} = \text{MPH}$.
4. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points it earns for each qualifying run.
5. The system is based on the dog's height at its withers:
18" or greater = handicap 1.0
12" up to, but less than 18" = handicap 1.5
Below 12" = handicap 2.0

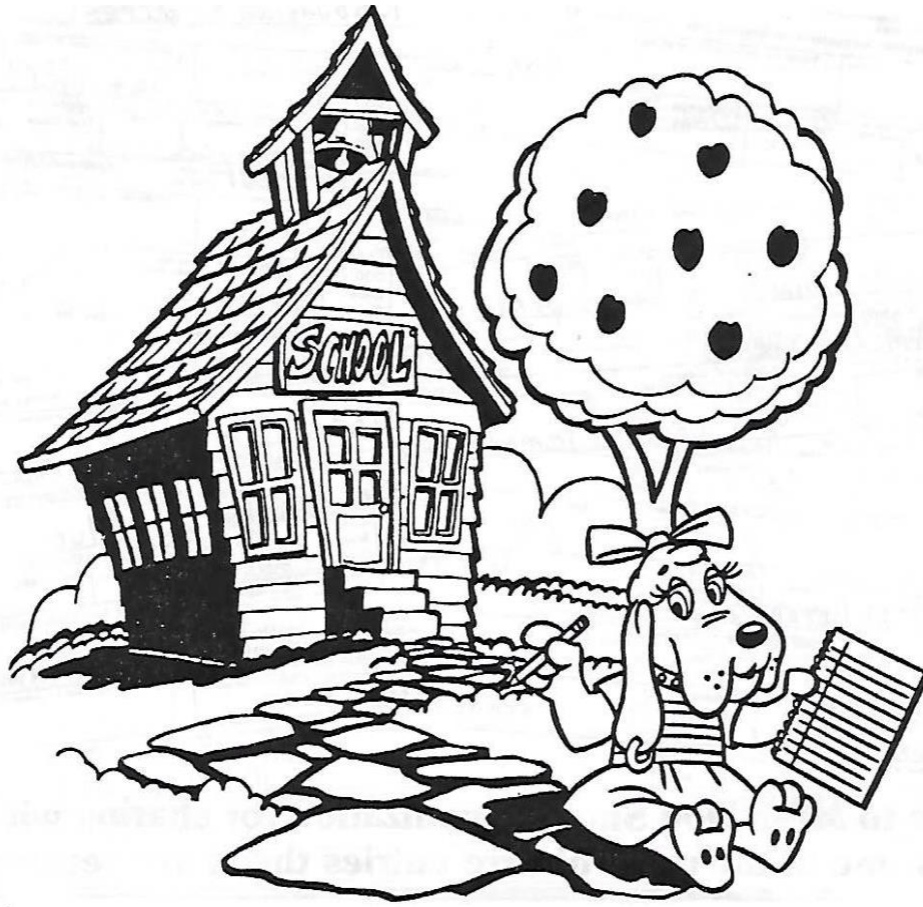
