All interested parties are invited to attend the draw. **Drawing for track order will be held at the Middle Oak Creek Campground (See "Routes to the Test" for directions).** TD draw will be at 7:45AM and judging will begin at 8:00AM or as soon as conditions permit. TDX draw will be at 10:00AM and judging will begin at 10:15AM or as soon as conditions permit.

Veterinary Emergency Services of Lincoln, 3700 S. 9th St., Suite M, 402-489-6800 Directions from test site Take W Raymond Rd (east) to Hwy 79 (south), Hwy 79 to Hwy 34 (east), Hwy 34 transitions into 9th St. (south). Continue south on 9th St and it will transition into Hwy 2 (east). At this curve, turn right onto Pioneers Blvd. The clinic will be to your right in line of businesses next to Shogun Restaurant. From park entrance to clinic - 19 miles.

AWARDS

All successful teams who pass will be presented an award to commemorate their track.

CERTIFICATION

An original statement dated within 2 years of this test must be included with the AKC entry form and fee for all dogs that have not passed an AKC TD test. Dogs entering the TDX test must have earned their TD title. A dog with a TD or TDX title may compete in either test.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES

Entries in the TD/TDX Tests will be accepted until the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limit has been reached. In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17 of the Tracking Regulations, a drawing will be held to determine which entries will participate in the Tests. The drawing will be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those entries which have not previously earned the specific Tracking title. Entries will be drawn by the Test Secretary at 7:00PM Friday, October 30, 2026, at Secretary's home. The Test Secretary will promptly notify all entrants and alternates.

If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and is exceeded in the other, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to a maximum of 12 TD or 6 TDX tracks total on a 1TDX/2 TD basis.

TEST WORKER OPTION

Per Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Regulations, 1 TD and 1 TDX track will be set aside for test workers. In the event that no TD entries are received then two (2) TDX tracks will be set aside for test workers.

Anyone who assisted at our 2025 Tracking Test will be eligible.

If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test workers are chosen.

Once the tracks set aside for workers are filled, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. There will be no separate alternate list for test workers only. A test worker may not benefit from a track set aside at a test in which they are working.

The test Secretary must be notified in writing and/or by checking the box located on the NKC Entry Form as to which track they would like to use for this option.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES

When the limit of 4 TD and 4 TDX entries has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preference set forth above, shall be assigned a position on the alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. Entry fees will be refunded or shredded for alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate list. Entry fees will also be refunded or shredded for alternates who do not participate in the test.

If a dog that is entered in the test, but does not run at the test and there is not an alternate to take that dogs place, the entry fee will not be refunded. Their certification will be returned to entrant per AKC.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. You must notify the test secretary of any bitch in season prior to the track draw on the day of the test.

ROUTES TO THE TEST

From the East: Take I-80 to Hwy 34 West (exit 401), north on Hwy 34 West to Hwy 79 (4.1 miles), Hwy 79 North to W. Raymond Rd. (5.0 miles), turn left (west) onto W. Raymond Rd. to park (3.2 miles), stay on W. Raymond Rd. to NW 140th (3.0 miles), turn right (north) onto NW 140th to W. Branched Oak Rd. (0.6 miles), turn right onto W. Branched Oak Rd. to the Middle Oak Creek campground entrance (1.25 miles), turn right into the campground, the draw site will be near the entrance.

From the South: Take Hwy 34 West to Hwy 79, then follow above directions

From the North: Take Hwy 79 South to W. Raymond Rd., turn right (west) then follow above directions.

From the West: Take I-80 to Hwy 15 (Seward Exit), North on Hwy 15 to Hwy 34 (in Seward), East on Hwy 34 to NW 112th, turn left (north) onto NW 112th to park. Turn left onto W. Raymond Rd. to NW 140th (2.1 miles) then follow above directions.

NEBRASKA STATE PARK REQUIREMENTS

All vehicles must have a Nebraska State Park permit to enter the park. Please follow this link to purchase passes. [NGPC - Product Catalog](#)

Or, buy a pass at the park. Passes are \$7.00 for Nebraska licensed vehicles and \$14.00 for vehicles not licensed in Nebraska.
